



Poster Presentations & General Instructions

All posters are to be mounted on the poster boards with number corresponding to the presenter's number and free for viewing by all.

- You should be printing and bringing your poster to the Conference.
- The dimensions of the poster **should NOT exceed 80cm wide x 100cm high**, in Portrait format.
- Prepare your poster to fit the dimensions specified. It is **mandatory** that poster be prepared on one sheet.
- Allocate the top of the poster for the **title and authors** as stated on the submitted abstract.
- Poster must be written and presented **mandatory** in English.
- The text, illustrations, etc. should be **bold enough** to be read from a distance of two meters (see paper template)

Abstract
This template should be used for submitting your abstract for the eighth International Conference "ENERGY in BUILDINGS" to be held in Athens, Hellas on Saturday September 28, 2019. Authors can use this template to insert their text directly in the document. Submissions should be original technical papers, not previously published elsewhere.

The Conference is organized by the ASHRAE Hellenic Chapter in collaboration with the Technical Chamber of Greece (TEE). It brings together professionals of all disciplines associated with the built environment including engineers, architects, professors, researchers, building owners, property managers and investors. Introduction [Level 1 Heading]
The abstract should provide a coherent overview and sufficient details about the background and technical content in order to reveal and substantiate the quality of the work. The word count of the abstract body should not exceed 400 words and fit in this template page. Authors may also include a couple of relevant references, if necessary. The main conference topics include: GREEN BUILDING DESIGN, OPERATION & MAINTENANCE, NEARLY OR NET ZERO AND NET POSITIVE ENERGY BUILDINGS, RENEWABLE ENERGY IN BUILDINGS, TRENDS IN HVAC SIMULATIONS & ENERGY MANAGEMENT, SMART BUILDINGS & CITIES, ADVANCES IN REFRIGERATION AND ALTERNATIVE REFRIGERANTS, EMBODIED ENERGY, LIFE CYCLE ASSESSMENT (LCA), ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN AND HIGH PERFORMANCE BUILDINGS, INDOOR ENVIRONMENT QUALITY (IEQ), HEALTH & COMFORT, DAYLIGHT & ARTIFICIAL LIGHTING, ADVANCED MATERIALS AND APPLICATIONS, REFURBISHMENT SOLUTIONS FOR IMPROVED ENERGY PERFORMANCE, HYBRID ALTERNATIVES FOR POWER AND HEAT BALANCING STORAGE AND DEMAND, SUSTAINABLE NEIGHBORHOODS, REGIONS AND CITIES.

Level 2 Heading
Abstracts should be submitted by May 27, 2019 to EinB2019@ashrae.gr. They will undergo peer-review by the Conference Scientific Committee. Full papers up to 10 pages must be submitted by July 22, 2019. Submitted full papers will also be peer-reviewed. Papers may be considered either for oral or poster presentation.
